**"Console Sets"**

What is a "Console Set"?

**Google**

A matched set usually containing a center bowl and a pair of candlesticks, popular in the 1920's and 1930's, either mold blown or pressed.

**Sharon Orienter, HCA member**

A glass bowl and a pair of candlesticks which match in pattern or decoration (e.g. cuttings and etchings) or both.

**Tom Felt et al, The Glass Candlestick Book, vol. 1, p 217 (Glossary)**

A combination of candlesticks and a floral bowl, usually in the same pattern, used as a centerpiece for a table setting. This practice became popular in the latter half of the 1920's, with most companies producing these combinations well into the 1930's or 1960's. Many decorating companies bought bowls and candlesticks from various sources, putting the sets together with their own decorations added, so that it is possible to find "matching" sets with pieces made by different glass factories.

Console bowls and console sets came into vogue with the advent of the table service made in glass during the 1920's... Some of the dinnerware lines offered two or three styles of console bowls and candlesticks were often available in single, duo or trident sizes. A few of the early bowls were [referred to](#) as centerpiece bowls ... Even though bowls and candlesticks were made to match (line numbers are the clue), it is possible to use similar styles together.
