Heisey and Heisey by Imperial Smoking Items

A checklist prepared for Great Plains Heisey Study Club July 2013 Eric Tankesley-Clarke

Underlined pattern numbers are not listed in the Heisev Index of Pattern Numbers, 1993 Calif. ed. Most added numbers were found in Heisey price lists or published in the Heisey News. An asterisk denotes a name that is either assigned by researchers or in general use among collectors, not originally from the company. A few patterns have no name. If no color is mentioned, the item is known only in crystal. If an item is known in more than one color (counting crystal as a color), the colors are listed below the item. It is possible that some items exist in Heisey or Imperial colors other than the ones listed. Other than for Winged Scroll, colors listed are either documented or ones I have personally seen.

While I have tried to be thorough, there may well be omissions or corrections. Please let me know if you find any.






This has been accepted as Heisey by many collectors, but there is no firm evidence Heisey ever produced this ash tray. Vogel seems to have the best information. Most other statements seem traceable to his research, even if they come to slightly different conclusions. Vogel says a Heisey employee made the mould (which seems to imply the mould may not have been made on the company's orders), but that different companies produced the piece. Heisey may or may not have produced one or two turns. Some examples are obviously inferior glass and not Heisey. Probably the mould was privately owned and taken to different companies from time to time. Amber ones are thought to have been made by Tiffin. Sometimes Viking is mentioned as a producer, but I have not seen that documented.



7122 NEWARK*

This refers to the same ash tray as HCA #8059; not same as Newark sesquicentennial from #1590 mold. The number 8059 is confirmed in a typed list in the HCA library; a goblet published in the Heisey News under that number is actually #8057. Because of confusion with the HCA number and because Vogel published first, it is best to use the Vogel number. An example is in the HCA museum. Not marked.

For the most part, these items were mentioned in Heisey factory price lists. It is certain or nearly so that #136, #1607, & #2500 are typographical errors, but they are included for completeness. Other than #3875, all were probably only in crystal.

In references above, H19 refers to Heisey News, Vol. 19 (1990), H20 to Vol. 20, 1991, and H32 to Vol. 32, 2003.

Summary

There are no fewer than 187 Heisey smoking items. If I've omitted anything, that will, of course, increase the total. The count will go up if you include the 4-horsehead ash tray, and some collectors might even add in lids and covers separately from bottoms. Accounting for every piece in every color, the total rises to at least 337. Adding the amber 4horsehead and the Imperial color pieces, and maybe that purple example of Old Gold, and you've reached at least 352. Five items were made by both Heisey and Imperial in crystal. They can often be distinguished with the right UV or other clues, raising the total even higher. One ash tray, the 51/2" Provincial, was made only by Imperial, but some collectors would add that. Some cigarette boxes were sold with or without covers, which could increase the total even more. Those of unknown appearance add at minimum 23 new items, and as many as 28, but they may not ever be identifiable so you may not wish to add them to the total. There are arguably close to 360 Heisey and Heisey by Imperial smoking items even without those unknowns. I have not accounted at all for Heisev factory decorations, and it would be impossible to list all decorations added after the glass left the factory. In short, there are hundreds of Heisev smoking items to keep the collector busy for a long, long time.
